It is also expected that 20-30 mins of reading will be undertaken each night along with approximately 5-10 minutes of tables work.

House Keeping Reminders

If for any reason your child is absent from school it is a legal requirement that this absence should be accounted for in writing. Absence slips are included in the school diary.

Sports days are Wednesday and Friday. These are the only days that sports uniform may be worn. If for some reason your child cannot wear correct uniform there is a uniform slip in the school diary that should be completed.

Library day is Monday.

Each child is allowed to borrow two books. One of these must be at their appropriate lexile level the other may be chosen from anywhere.
