Examinations are an important part of the teaching, learning and assessing cycle and a positive performance. These examinations will demonstrate a successful level of competency of key content and skills in each relevant Learning Area and will identify strengths, weaknesses that will lead into preparation for the final year of schooling in 2020. Please utilise all materials, course outlines and the SCSA syllabus to enhance your chance to maximise your marks and therefore your final Year 11 school grades. You are not permitted to eat during an examination, this includes lollies, chewing gum and any kind of drink except water in a clear plastic bottle, with the label removed, with a capacity of no more than 1.5 Litres. Students are not permitted to leave any examinations early.
