



St Joseph's School, Northam

Boarding Bursary

This bursary is designed to help with the boarding costs associated with a student, enrolled at St Joseph's, who wishes to board at the Northam Residential College.

This bursary will be awarded to a student who:

- Maintains a sound academic record reflective of their ability
- Has consistent attendance
- Displays expected behaviour at school and at the Residential College

If any of the above criteria are not met or there is an act of behaviour that warrants suspension or exclusion from the Residential College then the bursary may be withdrawn and the parents may have to repay the amount that the school has already paid to the Residential College.

The bursary will be a \$2500 contribution towards the fees of the Residential College. This will be paid directly to the Residential College upon receipt of proof of enrolment. Parents are expected to cover all other costs. The school will only be awarding up to four bursaries per year.

The bursary will be awarded to that student for a one year period. Families are required to submit an annual application form for renewal of the bursary. Renewal will be determined by the above criteria being met and the number of applications being received.

Families are invited to submit an application form, however this does not guarantee entry into either the school or the Residential College. Separate application forms are required for both. An interview will be required with the Principal before a decision is made regarding the success of the application.

This bursary cannot be used in conjunction with any other scholarship or bursary provided by the St Joseph's School.
