Pastoral Care

- **Assist students to manage social or emotional issues at school such as stress, friendships, bullying, personal issues or other concerns.**
- **Supporting students who are experiencing academic or school related difficulties**
- **Addressing behaviour management issues and supporting students with improvements in behaviour and school conduct**
